How is a trip set up? Trips are three nights and four days. We will travel on Wednesday, build, and take part in other ministry opportunities, and travel back home Saturday morning.

What is the cost involved? \$300 per person for food (8 meals) and lodging (3 nights).

What is the pre-trip commitment? Register and pay \$300 by Sunday, January 11th. Get passport ready and attend the Juarez meeting before the trip (TBD on date and location of the final meeting).

What are the accommodations in Mexico like? We stay at a comfortable, secure team center with Motel 6-type lodging rooms with bathrooms in each room. Each room holds up to four. We're fed like kings and have a great common area to hang out together. There's even a playground and basketball court.

Do we drive ourselves into Mexico? No. The team meets up at a church in El Paso, Texas. (A six-hour drive.) We leave our vehicles at a church and cross the border in Santa Teresa, NM in Missions Ministries vans. Carpools will be formed within the team for anyone who's interested.

What is accomplished by the team? We will build a house and hold a food outreach at a local church. Attend a local church service, and may do a prayer walk.
